



Guest Renovation FAQ's

What is the renovation plan for The Club?

The Club is undergoing extensive enhancements to elevate the day-to-day experience. The new design celebrates the property's heritage while incorporating modern, elegant touches.

Construction begins Monday, October 21st, 2024, and will last approximately six months.

Which areas of The Club will be renovated?

The renovation focuses on the pool, pool deck, Club Dining restaurant and patio, the Palm Room, and back-of-house areas.

What changes can we expect in the pool area?

The pool and pool deck will be completely re-tiled. The new deck will feature dynamic seating, family lounges, and private cabanas.

Hotel guests may use the pool at La Jolla Shores Hotel, with towels available on the pool deck.

What enhancements will be made to the Club Dining restaurant?

The restaurant will adopt a California bungalow aesthetic, with expanded seating and a kitchen upgrade, including a new pizza oven on the patio.

What areas will be impacted during the construction phase?

The construction zone will stretch from the Tennis desk to La Sala and the south end of The Club. This area will be closed off to guests.

Courts 1 and 3 will also be closed during construction. The Tennis desk will be relocated to the Court 8 viewing platform, and tennis court access will now be available at Court 8.

What alternative dining options are we offering hotel guests during the renovation?

- The Marine Room (Wednesday to Sunday): Hotel guests can enjoy breakfast and lunch, with Club Dining menu selections, accessible via the Esplanade.
- The Walnut Lounge (Monday to Friday): Cold provisions and a full bar will be available starting at 11:30 AM, and on weekends starting at 10 AM.
- The Shores restaurant: Open seven days a week with priority seating for hotel guests. Popular Club Dining dishes will be added to the restaurant menu, and in-room dining will be provided by The Shores restaurant.
- Complimentary Coffee (7 AM - 9 AM): Starting October 21st, hotel guests can enjoy complimentary coffee daily at The Shores restaurant. Coffee will also be available at The Walnut Lounge on Mondays and Tuesdays and at The Marine Room from Wednesday to Sunday.

Which amenities will remain open to guests?

The tennis courts, pickleball courts, The Walnut Lounge, beach services, Burgee Boutique, pro shop, gym, 3-par golf course, massage services, and bocce courts will remain open.

Will yoga still be available?

Yes, yoga classes will be offered on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 9 AM in Room 102 at The Club. Hotel guests can access via the Esplanade.

Parking will remain fully accessible for hotel guests.

What are the dining options for Thanksgiving Day?

The Marine Room will offer a fixed-course menu, while The Shores restaurant will provide a buffet.
